Taking in to consideration of sanitary restriction 50 people are participated in the program.

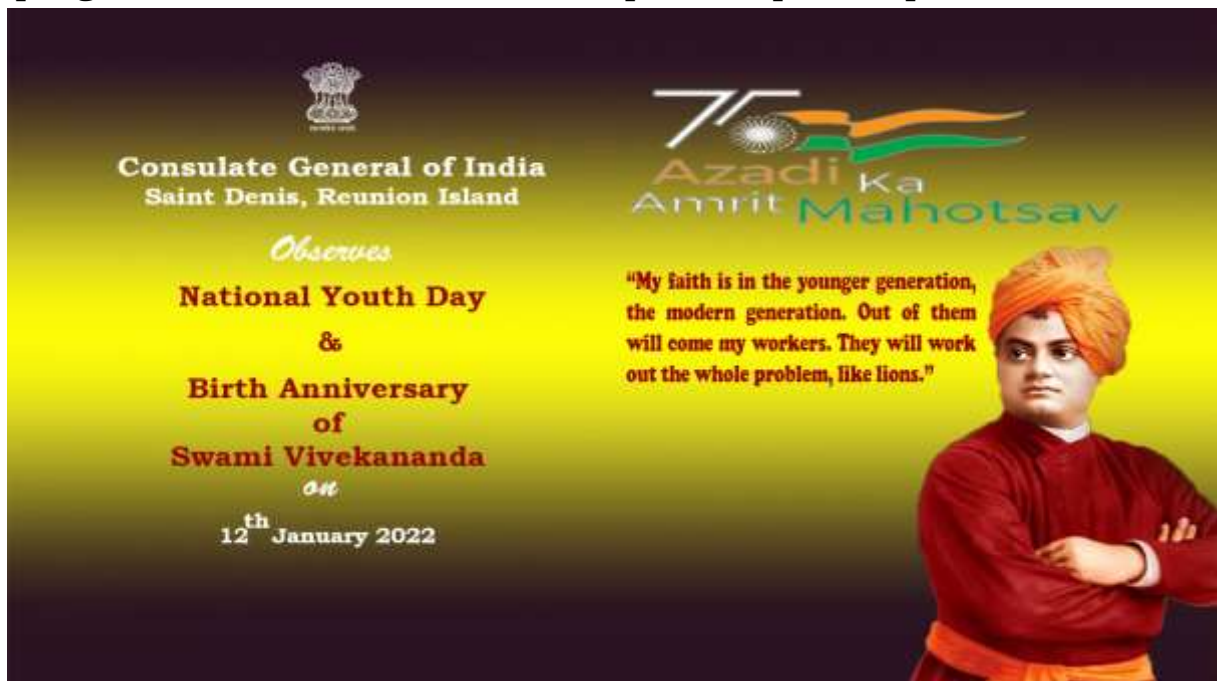
