


Activity Report for the Month of December 2021

15/12/2021 - India's Rich Cultural Heritage



The Cultural Center organized a short video presentation on India's rich cultural heritage- "Historical monuments and sculptures of India (Series 3)- "Tandava movements and dance of shiva" from the ancient text "Natyashastra" on the performing arts composed by bharathamuni. This text is dated to a period of around 2000 years ago, and has been the most influential in defining and shaping indian performing arts.
